Congratulations on your purchase of our high-quality neoprene wetboots. Designed with a durable rubber sole and a reliable YKK zip, these wetboots offer comfort, protection, and performance for water-based activities. This manual provides instructions for proper use, care, storage, and maintenance to ensure your wetboots perform at their best for years to come.

1. PRODUCT FEATURES

Material: Neoprene for flexibility and insulation. **Sole:** Robust rubber for grip and durability. **Zip:** YKK zip for ease of use and secure fit.

2. CORRECT USE

Intended Use:

Designed for water activities such as diving, snorkelling, paddle boarding, or sailing.

Provides thermal insulation and protection for your feet.

Fitting:

Ensure the boots fit snugly but not too tightly to maintain comfort and mobility. The YKK zip should slide smoothly and close securely.

3. CARE INSTRUCTIONS

After Use:

Rinse thoroughly with fresh water after exposure to salt-water, sand, or other contaminants. Pay special attention to the zip and sole to remove debris.

Cleaning:

Hand wash with mild soap and cool water if necessary. Avoid harsh detergents. Do not machine wash or tumble dry.

Drying:

Air-dry in a shaded, well-ventilated area.

Avoid direct sunlight, heaters, or other heat sources to prevent material degradation.

4. STORAGE

Short-Term Storage:

Ensure the boots are completely dry before storing. Keep them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

Long-Term Storage:

Store flat or in their natural shape to prevent creasing or damage.

Avoid stacking heavy items on top of the boots.

5. MAINTENANCE

Zip Care:

Lubricate the YKK zip periodically with a silicone-based lubricant to keep it functioning smoothly.

Check for and remove any debris stuck in the zip.

Inspection:

Regularly inspect boots for signs of wear, such as sole thinning or neoprene tears. Address minor damage promptly to prevent further deterioration.

Repairs:

Small neoprene tears can be repaired with a neoprene repair kit.

For extensive damage, consult a professional repair service.

6. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Always ensure the boots fit securely to prevent slipping or discomfort during use. Do not use the boots on rough, abrasive surfaces to avoid unnecessary wear on the sole.

Avoid prolonged exposure to oil, petrol, or other chemicals that may damage the material.

7. WARRANTY

These wetboots are covered by a limited warranty against manufacturing defects. This does not include damage caused by improper use, neglect, or unauthorised repairs.


